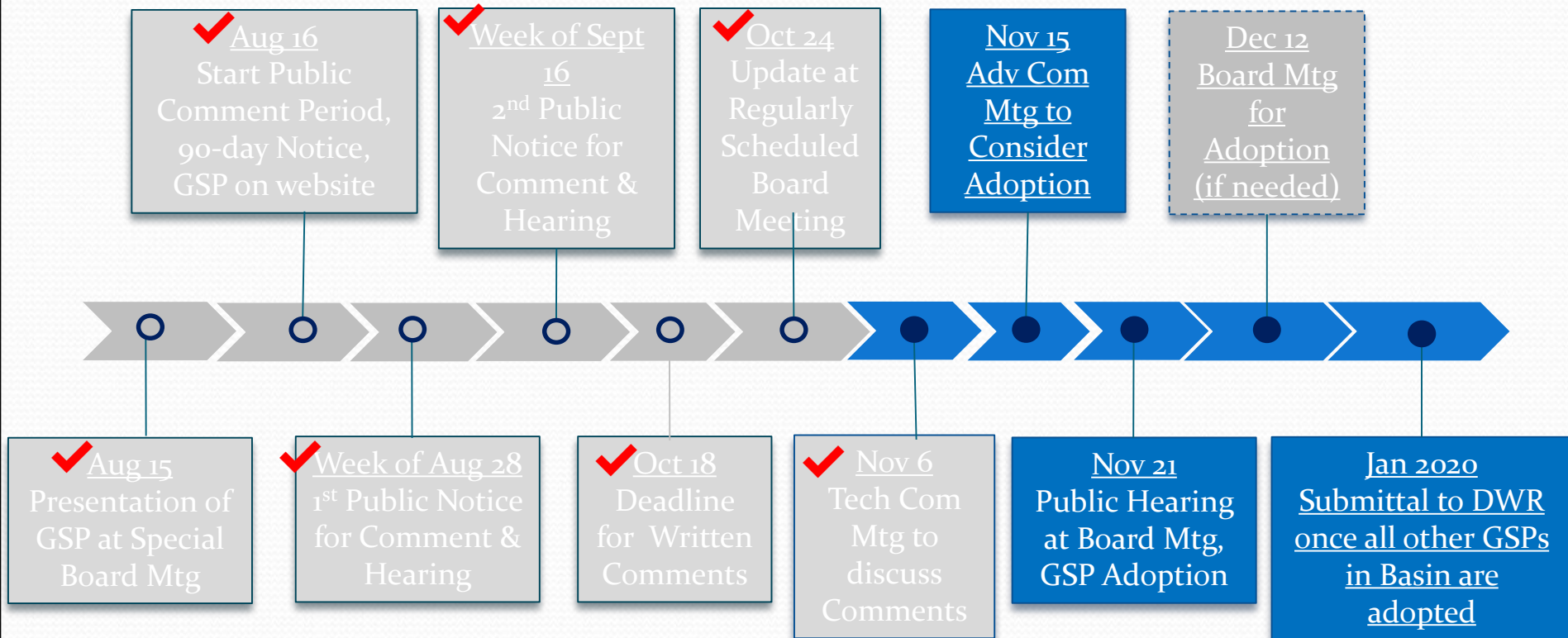
Kings Basin Update

- All GSPs out for public comment and set for December adoption
 - McMullin Area GSA adopted November 6
- Cooperative Agreement starting to be adopted
 - NKGSA adopted October 24
 - McMullin Area GSA adopted November 6
- Basin Data Management System development continues
- Preparing Grant application for \$500K for Basin
 - \$70K per GSA. Pulling pumps and video wells or monitor wells
- 1st annual report for Basin due April 1, 2020

Proposed GSP Revisions

- Domestic well impact analysis (Section 4.2.2.3)
 - Estimated between 3% and 12% of domestic wells may be affected at M.O., 13% to 32% at M.T.
 - Conservative (includes abandoned, destroyed, inactive wells)
- Monitoring network
 - WQ - Replaced some PWS wells, update MCLs
 - WQ/RMW – Outreach to well owners, agreements

Proposed GSP Revisions

- Clearly state NKGSA will continue effective stakeholder outreach, communication, and education
- Clarify that management actions will be triggered when M.T. is exceeded
- NKGSA will review proposed project impacts / CEQA
- Other minor changes for clarifications
