- ▶ DWR SGMA Implementation Grant Rd 1 (Projects starting)
  - ▶ \$4.8M, 4 Projects from 3 GSAs in Kings (FID-Savory, Kerman-Lions)
- ▶ DWR SGMA Funding - \$60M (possibly more)
  - ▶ Discussing Prioritization/Cost-share process
  - ▶ Get projects ready (start design/cost estimate, start CEQA, purchase/option land)

  - ▶ 15 recharge basin sites, over 500 acres, once completed will total over 15,000AF/yr on average
